MATERIALS:

AKNSH Panel that includes [32] 6-1/2"

1/3 yard City Names, Brown

7/8 yard Bees

1/3 yard Goldenrod

1/3 yard City Names, Yellow

1/3 yard Gingham Sunflower

7/8 yard Ditsy Flower

1-1/8 Meadowlark

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS
BEFORE BEGINNING. SEW PIECES RIGHT
SIDES TOGETHER (RST) AND USE A 1/4"
SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT. FOR THIS
PATTERN, WE WILL CUT STRIPS BY THE WOF
(WIDTH OF FABRIC)

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From AKNSH Panel:

Trim out [32] 6-1/2" squares from Panel

From City Names, Brown Fabric:

Cut [6] $-1-1/2" \times WOF$ strips (A)

From Bees Fabric:

Cut [6] - 1-1/2" \times WOF strips **(B)**

Cut $[7] - 2-1/2" \times WOF$ for binding

From Goldenrod Fabric:

Cut [6] $- 1-1/2" \times WOF strips$ (C)

From City Names, Yellow Fabric:

Cut $\lceil 6 \rceil - 1 - 1/2'' \times WOF$ strips (D)

From Gingham Sunflower:

Cut [6] $- 1-1/2" \times WOF$ strips (E)

From Ditsy Flower Fabric:

Cut [6] $-1-1/2" \times WOF$ strips (F)


Cut [6] $-2" \times WOF$ strips for inner border

From Meadowlark Fabric:

Cut [7] - 5-1/2" \times WOF for outer border

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

- 1. Using the $1-1/2" \times \text{WOF}$ strips **(A)** through **(F)**, sewing together to make strip sets in alphabetical order.
- 2. Press toward darker fabric.
- 3. Make [6] strip sets.
- 4. Cut the strip sets at 6-1/2" lengths. This should result in [35] 6-1/2" pieces.



QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:


- Using the [32] panel squares and the (A-F) strips sets, sew [9] rows.
- 2. Follow the diagram on the next page of the finished quilt to rotate dark & light sides of strip sets to get the desired layout.

BORDERS:

- Stitch [2] Ditsy Flower 2" strips together.
 Make [2] sets.
- 2. Measure quilt down middle to get length of side inner borders.
- 3. Trim as necessary.
- 4. Sew on inner border to both sides of quilt center.
- 5. Stitch extra Ditsy Flower 2" strips together.
- 6. Measure quilt across middle to get length of top and bottom borders.
- 7. Trim as necessary.
- 8. Sew on inner border to both sides of quilt center.
- 9. Repeat Steps 1-8 with the Meadowlark Fabric $5-1/2" \times \text{WOF}$ strips for the outer border.

FINISHING:

- 1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
- 2. Quilt as desired.
- 3. Bind using Meadowlark 2-1/2" strips.
- 4. Enjoy.
