

PRAIRIE SERENADE 77" x 89" Quilt



MATERIALS:

1 yard AKNSH Panel

[4] AKNSH Collectible Quilt Shop Blocks

1/4 yard Bees

1/2 yard City Names, Brown

1/4 yard Goldenrod

1-1/2 yards Gingham Sunflower

1-1/4 yard Fabric of choice for block frames (dark green in sample)

1-1/3 yard fabric for background (cream in sample)

1/2 yard Fabric of choice for inner border (brown in sample)

2-1/8 yards Meadowlark for outer border

4-5/8 yards for Backing

3/4 yard for Binding

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS
BEFORE BEGINNING. PRESHRINK AND
PRESS FABRICS. SEW PIECES RIGHT SIDES
TOGETHER (RST) AND USE A 1/4" SEAM
ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT. WOF = WIDTH
OF FABRIC, BG = BACKGROUND

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From AKNSH Panel:

Trim the floral strip (selvage edge) leaving 3/4" beside blocks. Carefully cut out each block at 7-1/2" square. Cut [14]

From AKNSH Collectible Quilt Blocks

Trim [4] blocks to 4-1/2" square

From Block Frame Fabric:

Cut [2] 7-1/2" \times WOF strips

Subcut to [52] 1-1/2" \times 7-1/2" rectangles **(C)**

Cut [2] 1-1/2" imes WOF strips

Subcut to [8] $1-1/2'' \times 7-1/2''$ rectangles **(C)**

Cut [2] $9-1/2" \times WOF$ strips

Subcut to [52] 1-1/2" \times 9-1/2" rectangles **(D)**

Cut [2] 1-1/2" \times WOF strips

Subcut to [8] $1-1/2" \times 9-1/2"$ rectangles **(D)**

From Bees Fabric:

Cut [2] - 7-1/2'' squares **(E)**

From City Names, Brown Fabric:

Cut [6] -7-1/2" squares **(F)**

From Goldenrod Fabric:

Cut [4] - 7-1/2'' squares **(G)**

From Gingham Sunflower:

Cut [3] $-6-1/2" \times WOF$ strips **(H)**

Cut $[3] - 9-1/2'' \times WOF$ strips (1)

From Background Fabric:

Cut [3] $2'' \times WOF$ strips

Subcut [1] strip to [8] $2'' \times 4-1/2''$ (A)

Subcut [2] strip to [8] $2'' \times 7-1/2''$ (B)

Cut [6] $3-1/2'' \times WOF$ strips (J)

Cut [8] 1-3/4" \times WOF strips **(K)**

From Fabric for Inner Border:

Cut [8] $- 1-1/2'' \times WOF strips$ (L)

From Meadowlark Fabric:

Cut [10] $-6-1/2" \times WOF$ for outer border (M)

From Binding Fabric:

Cut [10] $-2-1/2" \times WOF$ for binding (N)

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

AKNSH Collectible Quilt Store Block Unit

- 1. Using the Background $2'' \times 4-1/2''$ strips **(A)** to the sides the [4] AKNSH Collectible Quilt Store Blocks.
- 2. Set seams and press away from center.
- 3. Using the Background $2'' \times 7-1/2''$ strips **(B)** to top and bottom.
- 4. Set seams and press away from center. Unit should measure 7-1/2" square.

Framed Blocks

- 1. Using the [2] **(E)**, [6] **(F)**, [4] **(G)**, [4] AKNSH Collectible Quilt Store Unit, [14] AKNSH Panel centers, sew the Frame 1-1/2" × 7-1/2" rectangles **(C)** to both sides of all [30] blocks.
- 2. Set seams and press away from center.
- 3. Sew the Frame $1-1/2'' \times 9-1/2''$ rectangles **(D)** to the top and bottom of blocks. Unit will measure 9-1/2'' square.

Block Corner Units 1

Note: Placement of blocks must be determined before adding units below to blocks. Copy the diagram and note your placement choices.

- 1. Sew [3] Gingham Sunflower 6-1/2" \times WOF strips **(H)** to [3] 3-1/2" Background strips **(J)**.
- 2. Set seams and press towards print.
- 3. Cut units to 3-1/2" wide. Makes [30].

Block Corner Units 2

- 1. Sew [3] Gingham Sunflower 9-1/2" \times WOF strips (1) to [3] 3-1/2" Background strip (J).
- 2. Set seams and press towards print.
- 3. Cut units to 3-1/2" wide. Makes [30].



Diagram Block A

- 1. Using a Framed Block, sew a Corner Unit 1 to right side of block.
- 2. Set seam and press away from center.
- 3. Sew Corner Unit 2 to bottom.
- 4. Set seam and press away from center. Unit measures 12-1/2" square.

Diagram Block B

- 1. Using a Framed Block, sew a Corner Unit 1 to left side of block.
- 2. Set seam and press away from center.
- 3. Sew Corner Unit 2 to top.
- 4. Set seam and press away from center. Unit measures 12-1/2" square.




Diagram Block A Diagram Block B


QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

- 1. Following the Quilt Top diagram on next page, assemble and sew [5] vertical rows of [6] blocks.
- 2. Set seams. Press rows 1, 3, and 5 down, and rows 2 and 4 up. Vertical rows measure $12-1/2^n \times 72-1/2^n$.

BORDERS:

Background Border

1. Using Background 1-3/4" \times WOF strips **(K)**, trim selvages and assemble end to end with diagonal seam as diagrammed.



- 2. Cut [2] pieces to length of side—should be 72-1/2".
- 3. Assemble and sew to sides.
- 4. Set seams and press away from center.
- 5. Cut [2] pieces to width should be 63".
- 6. Assemble and sew to top and bottom.
- 7. Set seams and press away from center. Unit should measure $63'' \times 75''$.

Inner Border


- 1. Using $1-1/2'' \times \text{WOF}$ strips **(L)**, trim selvages and assemble end to end with diagonal seam.
- 2. Cut [2] pieces to length of side—should be 75".
- 3. Assemble and sew to sides.
- 4. Set seams and press away from center.
- 5. Cut [2] pieces to width should be 65".
- 6. Assemble to top and bottom.
- 7. Set seams and press away from center. Unit should measure $65^{"} \times 77^{"}$.

Outer Border

- 1. Using $6-1/2'' \times WOF$ strips **(M)**, trim selvages and assemble end to end with diagonal seam.
- 2. Cut [2] pieces to length of side—should be 77".
- 3. Assemble and sew to sides.
- 4. Set seams and press away from center.
- 5. Cut [2] pieces to width should be 77".
- 6. Assemble and sew to top and bottom.
- 7. Set seams and press away from center. Unit should measure $77" \times 89"$.

FINISHING:

- 1. Prepare backing. Seam will be horizontal.
- 2. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
- 3. Quilt as desired.
- 4. Bind using Binding 1-1/2" strips (N).
- 5. Label and Enjoy.
