PATHWAYS TO FRIENDSHIP

87-1/2" x 107-1/2"



MATERIALS:

- 1 yard AKNSH Panel
- 20 AKNSH Collectible Quilt Blocks
- 1-3/4 yards Pink with Gold Flowers
- 1-3/4 yards Cream with Pink Flowers
- 3/4 yard Bees
- 3/4 yard Gingham Sunflowers
- 2-1/8 yards Cities, Yellow
- 2-1/8 yards Cities, Brown
- 2-1/8 yards Birds, for Border
- 3/4 yard Classic Dot, Pink for Binding

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. PRESHRINK AND PRESS FABRICS. SEW PIECES RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER (RST) AND USE A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT. WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC, HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From AKNSH Panel:

Fussy Cut [12] Animal & Flower 5-1/2" squares

From AKNSH Collectible Quilt Blocks

Trim [20] blocks to 4-1/2" square

From Pink with Gold Flowers Fabric:

Cut [10] — 6" × WOF strips

Subcut into [60] 6" squares **(A)**

From Ditsy Flowers Fabric:

Cut [10] — 6" × WOF strips

Subcut into [60] 6" squares **(B)**

From Bees Fabric:

Cut [4] — 6" × WOF strips

Subcut into [20] 6" squares **(C)**

From Gingham Sunflowers Fabric:

Cut [4] — 6" × WOF strips

Subcut into [20] 6" squares **(D)**

From City Names, Brown Fabric:

Cut [5] — 6-3/4" × WOF strips

Subcut into [23] 6-3/4" squares **(E)**

Cut [10] — 3-3/4" × WOF strips

Subcut into [96] 3-3/4" squares **(G)**

From City Names, Yellow Fabric:

Cut [10] — 3-3/4" × WOF strips

Subcut into [92] 3-3/4" squares **(F)**

Cut [5] — 6-3/4" × WOF strips

Subcut into [24] 6-3/4" squares **(H)**

From Meadowlark Fabric:

Cut [11] — 6-1/2" × WOF

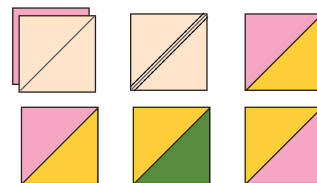
From Classic Dot, Pink Fabric:

Cut [9] — 2-3/4" × WOF for outer border

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Friendship Stars - Block A & Block B

1. Pair up the following 6" squares from cuts **(A-D)**
[20] **(A)** squares / [20] **(D)** squares
[20] **(B)** squares / [20] **(C)** squares
[40] **(B)** squares / [40] **(A)** squares
2. Place squares RST in pairs. Draw a diagonal line on the **(A)** square in first group, and on the **(B)** other two grouping.
3. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of the marked line of all [80] pairs.
4. Cut on marked diagonal line and press to the darker side.
5. Trim all HST blocks to 5-1/2" square.
6. You will have [40] **(A/D)**, [40] **(B/C)**, [80] **(B/A)** HST.



- Note:** If you are using the AKNSH Quilt Shop Blocks: Cut [4] 1" strips from the remainder of the 6" strips above for each Shop Block. Sew to each side and trim to 5-1/2". These can also be used as corner stones for Geese Blocks or centers of Friendship Star Blocks.
7. Using the Animal & Flower 5-1/2" cuts for the center square, create the Friendship Star Blocks. Follow the layouts in Diagram 1A and Diagram 1B. Sew the horizontal rows first, then the [3] rows vertically.

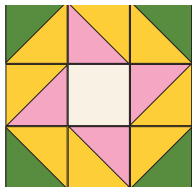

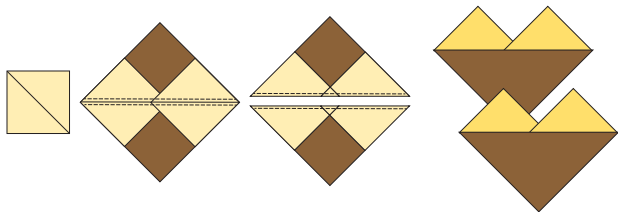


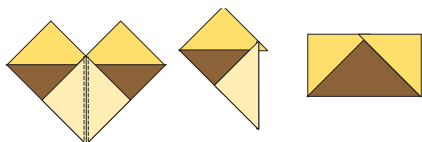

Brown Cities Flying Geese - Block C

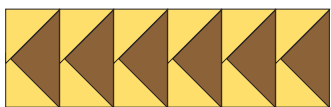
1. Draw line diagonally corner to corner on wrong side of each City Names, Yellow 3-3/4" squares **(F)**.
2. Place [2] of the City Names, Yellow 3-3/4" squares RST on a City Names, Brown 6-3/4" square **(E)**. Pin in place.
3. Sew a scant 1/4" seam on each side of line.
4. Cut on drawn line.
5. Press toward the City Names, Brown triangle.



6. Place another City Names, Yellow 3-3/4" square on the brown tip as below. Pin. Draw diagonal line.
7. Sew scant 1/4" seam on each side of diagonal line on City Names, Yellow triangle.
8. Cut on drawn line.
9. Press open to create [4] Flying Geese blocks. Trim to 3" x 5 1/2".



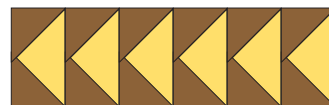
10. Repeat with the other [23] 6-3/4" City Names, Brown squares - creating [92] Brown Flying Geese.
11. Sew [6] Flying Geese together, top to bottom, into [15] Flying Geese - Block C.



Yellow Cities Flying Geese - Block D

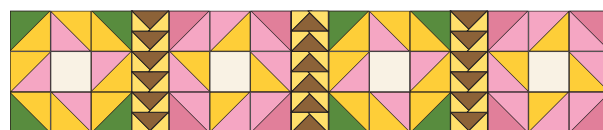
1. Draw line diagonally corner to corner on wrong side of each City Names, Brown 3-3/4" squares **(G)**.

2. Place [2] of the City Names, Brown 3-3/4" squares RST on a City Names, Yellow 6-3/4" square **(H)**. Pin in place.
3. Repeat steps 3-11 from Flying Geese Block C. Make 96.



QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

1. Following the Quilt Top diagram. Create the [9] rows.
2. Sew the rows together, according to the diagram.

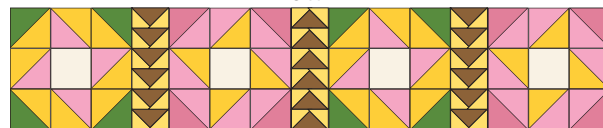

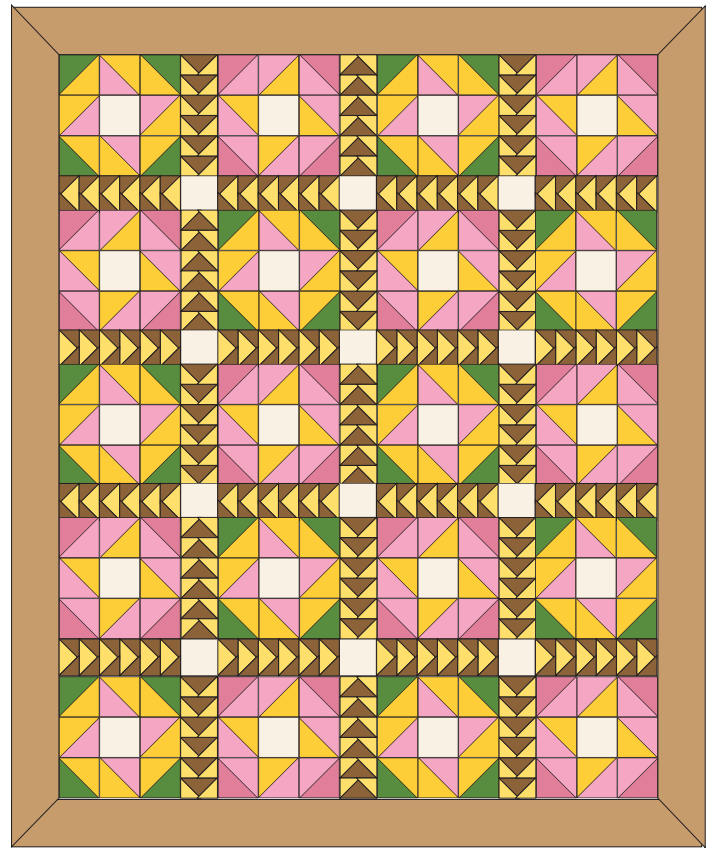

BORDERS:

1. Using Meadowlark, sew [2] sets of [3] strips together end to end.
2. Sew to each side of the Quilt Top, only sewing to 1/4" of each end of quilt.
3. Sew [2] sets of [2] strips together end to end.
4. Sew to top and bottom of the Quilt Top.
5. Miter corners for best look.

FINISHING:

1. Layer quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind using Classic Dot Pink fabric 2-3/4" strips.
4. Label and Enjoy!
