

PRAIRIE STARS

84" x 104" Queen Quilt



MATERIALS:

[100] AKNSH Collectible Quilt Store Blocks, or 4-1/2" Dots, White squares

2-1/4 yards Floral, Violet

1-5/8 yard Town Toss, Violet

5/8 yard Dots, Violet

4 yards Dots, White (more needed to fill in for any missing Quilt Store Blocks)

1-1/2 yards Floral, Orange

1-5/8 yards Town Toss, Orange

5/8 yard Dots, Orange

92" x 112" Hobbs Heirloom 80/20 Batting

7-3/4 yards fabric for Backing

RECOMMENDED TOOLS:

Creative Grids, The Big Easy
12-1/2" × 24-1/2" Ruler - #CGR1224
Creative Grids, 4-1/2" Square Ruler - #CGR4
Bloc Loc 4" Triangle in a Square Ruler - #TIS-4
or Half Rectangle and Bias Triangle Rulers

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. PRESHRINK AND PRESS FABRICS. SEW PIECES RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER (RST) AND USE A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGH-OUT. WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC, HST = HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLES, TIAS = TRIANGLE IN A SQUARE, 2AAT HST = 2 AT A TIME HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From Floral, Violet Fabric:

Cut [9] - 5-1/4" \times WOF strips Subcut [60] - 5-1/4" squares **(A)**

Cut [11] - 2-1/2" \times WOF strips for binding. Remove selveges. **(R)**

From Dots, Violet Fabric:

Cut [3] - 5-1/8" \times WOF strips* Subcut [40] - Bloc Loc Center Triangles **(E)**

From Town Toss, Violet Fabric:

Cut [7] - 5-1/8" × WOF strips*

Subcut [40] Bloc Loc Center Triangles (B)

Subcut [40 pairs] Bloc Loc Side Triangles (C)

Cut [3] - 5-1/4" × WOF strips Subcut [20] - 5-1/4" squares **(D)**

From Dots, White Fabric:

Cut [12] - 5-1/4" \times WOF strips Subcut [80] - 5-1/4" squares **(F)**

Cut [8] - 5-1/8" \times WOF strips* Subcut [80 pairs] Bloc Loc Side Triangles **(G)**

Cut [2] - 4-1/2" × WOF strips Subcut [13] - 4-1/2" squares **(H)** NOTE: Cut additional squares to fill in for any missing AKNSH Collectible Quilt Store Blocks.

Cut [10] - 2-1/2" \times WOF strips for border (S)

From Floral, Orange Fabric:

Cut [9] - 5-1/4" \times WOF strips* Subcut [60] - 5-1/4" squares (J)

From Town Toss, Orange Fabric:

Cut [7] - 5-1/8" × WOF strips Subcut [40] Bloc Loc Center Triangles **(K)** Subcut [40 pairs] Bloc Loc Side Triangles **(L)**

Cut [3] - 5-1/4" \times WOF strips Subcut [20] - 5-1/4" squares **(M)**

From Dots, Orange Fabric:

Cut [3] - 5-1/8" × WOF strips*
Subcut [40] Bloc Loc Center Triangles (N)
If using the Half Rectangle and Bias Triangle rulers, cut these strips to 4-1/2" instead of 5-1/8". Cut the designated number of units from the strips.

From AKNSH Collectible Store Quilt Blocks:

Trim [100] - 4-1/2" squares.


NOTE: Use Dots, White for any squares in excess of what you have not collected. Additional fabric would be required to make substitutions.

Design Idea: Feature the [6] Region Blocks and [1] State Block on the back of the quilt.

BLOCK UNITS:2 AT-A-TIME HALF-SQUARE TRIANGLES (2AAT HST)







Using 5-1/4" squares, pair the following to create 2 At-A-Time HST:

[40] Dots, White **(F)** / [40] Floral, Orange **(J)** - Makes [80] HST

[20] Floral, Orange (J) / [20] Word Toss, Orange (M) — Makes [40] HST

[40] Dots, White **(F)** / [40] Floral, Violet **(A)** - Makes [80] HST

[20] Violet, Floral **(A)** / [20] Word Toss, Violet **(D)** — Makes [40] HST

- 1. Using a pencil or fabric marking tool, draw a line diagonally from corner to corner on the back of one of each pair of fabrics.
- 2. Place [2] designated squares RST.
- 3. Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line.
- 4. Cut on the drawn line to separate HST.
- 5. Open and press to reveal [2] HST.
- 6. Trim to 4-1/2" square HST.

TRIANGLE IN A SQUARE (TIAS)



The following instructions utilize the Bloc Loc 4" Triangle in a Square ruler. If using a different TIAS ruler, verify the size to cut fabric and also the method to create the units.

- 1. Cut strips of fabric $5-1/8" \times WOF$ as stated in the Cutting Instructions. These units use cuts (**B,E,K and N**)
- 2. To cut the center triangles, place the center triangle ruler on the fabric strip. Cut designated number of center triangles.

- 3. To cut the side triangles, fold the strip of fabric in half lengthwise. It will be 5-1/8" W × aprx. 20" L. Place the side triangle ruler on the fabric strip. Cut designated number of side triangles. Each cut gives you one set (a right and a left side triangle).
- 4. Align one side triangle on the center triangle. Sew. Press.
- 5. Align the second side triangle on the center triangle. Sew. Press.
- 6. Using the Bloc Loc TIAS square up ruler, trim excess fabric to create a 4-1/2" TIAS. To use the Half Rectangle and Bias Triangle rulers, cut the strips 4-1/2". Use the rulers to cut the designated number of units. Make sure you cut the Half Rectangles in pairs so the two triangles are opposite.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Create [10] of each block: Block #1 Violet & Block #2 Orange.

Example, Block #1 Violet, is created using: [5] Collectible Store Blocks or Dots, White


[8] HST: Floral, Violet/Dots, Whites

[4] HST: Floral, Violet/Word Toss, Violet

[4] TIAS: Dots, White/Word Toss, Violet


[4] TIAS: Word Toss, Violet/Dots, Violet

- 1. Arrange units according to Figure below.
- 2. Sew neighboring units together to create a row. Press.
- 3. Sew neighboring rows together to create a block. Press.
- 4. Block #2 Orange is made with the corresponding HST and TIAS out of Dots, Orange, Town Toss and Floral.



QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:


- 1. Layout blocks as shown in Figure below.
- 2. Sew neighboring blocks together matching points to create rows. Press.
- 3. Sew rows together to create the quilt top. Press.



BORDER ASSEMBLY:

Uses Dots, White 2-1/2" \times WOF strips **(S)** to make [2] Top/Bottom Borders measuring 2-1/2" \times 84-1/2"; [2] Side Borders measuring 2-1/2" \times 100-1/2".

- 1. To achieve the necessary length for each border, place [2] fabric strips RST. Sew seam across the short end. Press.
- 2. Measure length. Add an additional strip(s) if necessary to achieve desired length.
- 3. Trim excess fabric.
- 4. Attach side borders. Press.
- 5. Attach top and bottom borders. Press.



FINISHING:

BACKING

- 1. Using 40" wide fabric, cut [3] $92" \times WOF$.
- 2. Using a 1/2" seam allowance, sew together along the long side. Press.

BINDING

Note: This creates a backing $92'' \times 118''$, which allows 4'' around the perimeter of the quilt. Check with your quilter to verify their preferred measurements for longarm or machine quilting.

- Using the Floral, Violet 2-1/2" × WOF strips (R), sew together end to end using a diagonal seam.
- 2. Cut excess fabric 1/4" from seam. Press seam open.
- 3. Fold binding in half lengthwise. Press.
