

QUILT SHOP ALL-STARS

72" x 72" Quilt



MATERIALS:

[1] AKNSH Panel
3 yards AKNSH Border Print
1/2 Floral, Orange
1-1/4 yard Town Toss, Peach
1-2/3 yards Floral, Violet
7/8 yard Sign Toss
2/3 yards Roads
1/4 yard Dots, Violet
1/2 yard Dots, Orange

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. PRESHRINK AND PRESS FABRICS. SEW PIECES RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER (RST) AND USE A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGH-OUT. WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC, LOF = LENGTH OF FABRIC

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From AKNSH Border Print:

Cut [2] - $50'' \times WOF$ strips Subcut [8] - $8-1/2'' \times 50''$ strips for borders Fussy cut [4] - 6-1/2'' squares **(B)**

From Floral, Orange Fabric:

Cut [2] - 6-7/8" \times WOF strips Subcut [8] - 6-7/8" squares Cut each square in half diagonally twice. **(D)**

From Town Toss, Orange Fabric:

Cut [1] - 6-7/8" × WOF strip

Subcut [4] - 6-7/8" squares

Cut each square in half diagonally twice. (F)

Cut [3] - 6-3/16" × WOF strips

Subcut [16] - 6-3/16" squares (E)

Cut [1] - 12-3/4" × WOF strip

Subcut [2] - 12-3/4" squares

Cut each square in half diagonally once. (H)

From Floral, Violet Fabric:

Cut [2] – 12-3/4" \times WOF strips Subcut [4] – 12-3/4" squares Cut each square in half diagonally once. **(G)**

From Tossed Signs Fabric:

Cut [8] - $2'' \times$ WOF strips for binding

From Roads Fabric:

Cut [1] - 20-1/2" \times WOF strip Crosscut into [2] - 20-1/2" squares Cut each square in half diagonally once. **(L)**

From Dots, Violet Fabric:

Cut [2] - 2-1/2" \times WOF strips **(K)**

From Dots, Orange Fabric:

Cut [2] - 1-1/2" \times WOF strip Subcut [8] - 1-1/2" \times 6-1/2" rectangles **(A)** Subcut [8] - 1-1/2" \times 8-1/2" rectangles **(C)** Cut [2] - 2-1/2" \times WOF strips **(J)**

From AKNSH Panel:

Trim panel to $20-1/2" \times 16-1/2"$

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:


4 STAR UNITS:

- 1. Sew the Dots, Orange $1-1/2'' \times 6-1/2''$ rectangles **(A)** onto both sides of a 6-1/2'' AKNSH Border print square **(B)**.
- 2. Sew the Dots, Orange $1-1/2'' \times 8-1/2''$ rectangles **(C)** onto the top and bottom. Make [2].
- 3. Repeat using all [4] 6-1/2" AKNSH Border print squares.





4. Sew the long sides of [2] Floral Orange triangles **(D)** to [2] adjacent sides of each Town Toss, Peach 6-3/16" square **(E)**. Make [16] units.





6. Sew [2] of these units to the tops and bottoms of [2] Border print units from Step 3.



7. To the remaining [8] of the **(DE)** units from Step 4, add a Town Toss, Peach triangle **(F)** to the outer edges.



8. Sew [1] **(DEF)** unit to the top of [1] Border print unit. Sew [1] **(DEF)** unit to the bottom of [1] Border print unit. Pay attention to orientation of the Border print.



9. Sew [1] **(DEF)** unit to the right side of [1] Border print unit. Sew [1] **(DEF)** unit to the left side of [1] Border print unit. Pay attention to orientation of the Border print. The remaining [4] units will be pieced with the borde



- 10. Paying careful attention to the direction of the Border print units, sew [2] Floral, Purple triangles (G) to the top adjacent sides of [1] Border print unit from Step 8.
- 11. Sew [2] Floral, Purple triangles **(G)** to the bottom adjacent sides of [1] Border print unit from Step 8.





12. Sew [2] Word Toss, Peach triangles **(H)** on each side of Border print units from Steps 10 and 11.



- 13. Sew [2] Floral, Purple triangles **(G)** to the right adjacent sides of [1] Border print unit from Step 9.
- 14. Sew [2] Floral, Purple triangles **(G)** to the left adjacent sides of [1] Border print unit from Step 9.




STATE BLOCK UNIT:

 Sew a Dot, Orange 2-1/2" × WOF (J) to a Dots, Violet 2-1/2" × WOF (K). Make 2. Press to Dots, Violet.



2. Crosscut into [32] 2-1/2" pieces.



3. Sew [4] units together end to end alternating Violet and Orange. Make [2].



4. Sew a unit to both short sides of State panel. Note that left side has Orange for top square and right side has Violet for top square.



5. Sew [12] pieces of Orange/Violet Dot segments together in a checkerboard style.



6. Sew to the top and bottom of the State panel. Panel should now measure 24-1/2" \times 24-1/2".



7. Sew the units from Step 14 to the right and left of the State center unit.



8. Sew the top and bottom units from Step 12 to the center panel.



9. Add a Roads triangle **(L)** to each corner of the State center unit.



BORDER ASSEMBLY:

1. To make the borders, layer [4] of the 50" borders all facing right side up with quilt shops all going same direction. Cut a 45 degree angle off of the left side making the quilt shop side longer than the street side.



 For the other [4] strips of border, stack them directional and cut a 45 degree angle off the RIGHT side leaving the quilt shop side longer than the street side.



3. Sew a border piece to a triangle unit **(DEF)** saved from earlier. Make [4] with the border print street side down and the triangle unit on the right. Sew the remaining [4] border pieces to the right sides of the triangle units. Leave these borders long, DO NOT TRIM TO SIZE OF SIDES!



- 4. Sew borders to all sides of quilt center, matching seams with the triangle units and border print squares. Start and stop sewing 1/4" from edge of quilt center corner. If you have never mitered a corner, find an online tutorial to explain the process.
- 5. Miter border corners using your method of choice.



FINISHING:

BACKING

1. Layer, quilt, bind with the Toss Sign $2'' \times WOF$ strips and enjoy!
