MATERIALS:

1-1/2 yards Blender Parchment Swirl

1-1/8 yards Quilt Block Toss Red

1-1/8 yards Blender Black

1-3/4 yards Quilt Block Toss Cream,
includes binding

7/8 yard Chickens Red

7/8 yard Chickens Black

READ THROUGH ALL INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING. SEW PIECES RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER AND USE A 1/4" SEAM ALLOWANCE THROUGHOUT UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED. WOF - WIDTH OF FABRIC; RST - RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER; HST - HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

From Blender Parchment Swirl Fabric:

Cut [20] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [24] — 10-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(A)**

Subcut [24] — 8-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(B)**

Subcut [24] — 6-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(C)**

Subcut [24] — 4-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(D)**

Subcut [24] — 2-1/2" squares **(E)**

From Quilt Block Toss Red Fabric:

Cut [8] — 2" × WOF strips, Border

Cut [7] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [12] — 8-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(F)**

Subcut [12] — 6-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(G)**

Subcut [12] — 4-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(H)**

Subcut [12] — 2-1/2" squares **(I)**

From Blender Black Fabric:

Cut [8] — 2" × WOF strips, Border

Cut [7] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [12] — 8-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(J)**

Subcut [12] — 6-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(K)**

Subcut [12] — 4-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(L)**

Subcut [12] — 2-1/2" squares **(M)**

From Quilt Block Toss Cream Fabric:

Cut [14] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [24] — 8-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(N)**

Subcut [24] — 6-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(O)**

Subcut [24] — 4-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(P)**

Subcut [24] — 2-1/2" squares **(Q)**

Cut [8] — 2-1/4" or 2-1/2" × WOF strips, Binding

From Chickens Red Fabric:

Cut [10] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [12] — 10-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(R)**

Subcut [12] — 8-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(S)**

Subcut [12] — 6-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(T)**

Subcut [12] — 4-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(U)**

Subcut [12] — 2-1/2" squares **(V)**

From Chickens Black Fabric:

Cut [10] — 2-1/2" × WOF strips

Subcut [12] — 10-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(W)**

Subcut [12] — 8-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(X)**

Subcut [12] — 6-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(Y)**

Subcut [12] — 4-1/2" × 2-1/2" rectangles **(Z)**

Subcut [12] — 2-1/2" squares **(AA)**

BLOCK ASSEMBLY:

Quarter Log Cabin Blocks

1. Sew **(Q)** square to the bottom edge of **(V)** square.
2. Sew **(P)** rectangle to the left edge of the block.



3. Sew **(U)** rectangle to the bottom edge of the block.
4. Sew **(T)** rectangle to the left edge of the block.



5. Sew **(O)** rectangle to the bottom edge of the block.
6. Sew **(N)** rectangle to the left of the block.



7. Sew **(S)** rectangle to the bottom edge of the block.
8. Sew **(R)** rectangle to the left of the block. Measures 10-1/2" square. Make [12] Quilt Toss Block Cream/Chickens Red blocks.



9. Repeat to make [12] Quilt Toss Block Cream/Chickens Black blocks using the order: **(Q)-(AA)-(P)-(Z)-(Y)-(O)-(N)-(X)-(W)**



10. Repeat to make [12] Blender Parchment Swirl/Quilt Block Toss Red blocks using the order: **(I)-(E)-(H)-(D)-(C)-(G)-(F)-(B)-(A)**



11. Repeat to make [12] Blender Parchment Swirl/Blender Black blocks using the order: **(M)-(E)-(L)-(D)-(C)-(K)-(J)-(B)-(A)**



QUILT TOP ASSEMBLY:

1. Assemble the [4] block types as depicted in the layout below.
2. Sew neighboring blocks together to create a row of [6] blocks. Press in alternating directions by row.

3. Sew neighboring rows together to create row pairs. Sew row pairs together to make halves. Sew halves together to make pieced top.



BORDER ASSEMBLY

1. Sew Blender Black border strips together end to end. Measure the height of quilt top and cut [2] strips for sides. Sew to quilt. Press toward the border.
2. Measure the width of quilt top and cut [2] strips for top and bottom. Sew to quilt. Press toward the border.
3. Repeat the above process to attach Quilt Block Toss Red border.



FINISHING:

1. Layer the quilt top with batting and backing.
2. Quilt as desired.
3. Bind with [8] — Quilt Block Toss Cream - 2-1/4" or 2-1/2" strips.
4. Label & Enjoy!
